

Submission Guidelines

I. Purpose

The Asian Environmental Law Review (AELR) welcomes submissions of research papers in the field of environmental law, especially international environmental law and comparative environmental law.

We expect the majority of AELR submissions will be in Chinese, but submissions in English are also welcomed. English will be the main language of communication.

AELR will be published quarterly. Our mission is to promote the understanding of Asian environmental laws and legal issues.

II. Submission

1. Manuscript Guidelines

- a. We welcome research articles of 8,000–10,000 words in Chinese or 4,000–6,000 words in English (including text, abstract, keywords, footnotes, diagrams, and appendices).
- b. Please attach a 200-word abstract, 5 keywords, and the author's name and current position. Notes should conform to standard academic style.
- c. Manuscripts that have been previously published, those that contain a significant amount of previously published material, and those that are under consideration for publication elsewhere will be rejected.
- d. To ensure the objectivity of the review process, please do not include any identifying information in the text or footnotes.

2. To submit your manuscript, please register with the E-Journal Review System at <http://jrs.edubook.com.tw/AELR/>.

3. The *Review* uses a double-blind review system. After the manuscript is reviewed, the author will be notified with the reviewers' comments and final decision of the editorial board. The time of publication will be decided by the editorial board.

4. The authors of any paper published in the journal agree to transfer all print and digital copyrights to Angle Publishing. Digital rights include reproduction, inclusion in a database, public transmission and distribution, and similar activities.
